


E-Books

How to download your e-book version from the AAST and the Vital Source web servers

The system is simple! Each student has a redemption code for each of their books were they can download it to their computer and view it through a program called "Vital Book Shelf".

Here are the Steps in Details:

1. Visit <http://studybooks.aast.edu/>

2. Enter your Registration # and Pin (the ones you use to get your results).
